DIAGNOS launches Manageo, a turnkey, web-based mining claim management service

“This application will greatly simplify the management of mining claims that we have staked on behalf of clients”, stated Michel Fontaine, VP, DIAGNOS. “Manageo will be sold as an annual subscription and is currently available in English and French. It is intended for use by mining companies operating in the provinces of Quebec and Ontario but could be modified for other jurisdictions as the demand develops.”
